After parking your car in the "Fever Outpatient Parking lot", please call us and our staff will guide you. You can take all procedures including reception, questionnaire, and exam without getting off the car.

Visitor Restriction

We currently do not accept any visitors, including patient family, except under special circumstances such as;

- · Our hospital staff asked you to come
- · The patient's condition is unstable or has suddenly deteriorated
- Accompanying an inpatient aged 12 or under

Even under those circumstances, we cannot accept visitors who have cold symptoms or a temperature of 37.5°C or higher.

When you are accepted as a visitor, please be aware of the following.

- Up to 2 visitors are allowed for a short time.
- Wear a mask and use hand sanitizer when entering and leaving the patient room.
- Let us know about your health condition on the "Questionnaire" on your visit.
